

Muslim Advocacy:



In witnessing horrific and deeply upsetting atrocities around the world, ADAMS was able to support its community throughout 2023 in providing education, spaces for spiritual support, and channels of action for community members such as the historic Jummah in DC in lieu of our own (https://adamscenter.org/activism/). With your generosity, ADAMS was able to raise and distribute almost \$600,000 in relief for Muslims all around the world that are suffering, oppressed, and in desperate need. We continue to make du'a for our brothers and sisters in Palestine, especially those in Gaza, who are suffering through a genocide and constant crimes against humanity.

Education

Alhamdulillah, our education programs continued to grow in 2023, highlighting a growing and more diverse community that we have had the opportunity to serve. Our youth across every age range filled our facilities and brought a sense of purpose and energy to our programs and initiatives.



Branch Development

ADAMS continues to invest in its sprawling and diverse community through its various branch locations. Where each branch conveys its own unique contributions to ADAMS at large, ADAMS in 2023 was able to provide a common thread of governance to help establish the beginnings of a more capable branch model, with programming and presence, that will sustain the ADAMS community for years to come in its growth trajectory.



ADAMS Office of the Imam

Looking Ahead






ADAMS Leesburg:

In 2023, ADAMS Leesburg achieved significant milestones, including:





New Sports Turf Field: A new soccer turf field was built, providing a space for sports activities and community events.

Increased Attendance: Daily prayer attendance continued to grow, with over 500 attendees each week at Jummah prayers.

ADAMS Sully:

ADAMS Sully is a dynamic branch that offers a wide range of programs and services to meet the needs of its diverse community. With three Jumu'ah locations offering **eight Friday prayers**, ADAMS Sully ensures that community members have ample opportunity to participate in communal worship.

In 2023, ADAMS Sully introduced and expanded upon several initiatives, including:

- Monthly Chai & Convos and Ice Cream Socials: These events provide opportunities for community members to connect and socialize in a relaxed setting.
- ADAMS Compassionate Healthcare Network (ACHN): This program continues to serve underprivileged individuals by providing access to healthcare services.
- **Expanded Educational Offerings:** New classes on Seerah, Tajweed, and Ageedah/Creed.
- ADAMS Sully is committed to fostering a strong sense of community through its diverse programming and partnerships with local organizations. The branch is also dedicated to empowering its youth, who play an active role in supporting Jumu'ah and other operations.

ADAMS EDUCATION: NURTURING HEARTS AND MINDS

In 2023, the program celebrated its first graduating class, marking a significant milestone in our commitment to adult education.

Children's Education Program (CEP): Nurturing Young Hearts

Children's Education Program (CEP) provides a **fun and engaging learning environment for children** ages 4-11. Through interactive lessons, creative activities, and character-building exercises, we instill in young learners a love of Islam and a strong foundation in Islamic values.

Youth Education Program (YEP): Empowering the Next Generation

Youth Education Program (YEP) is designed to **empower young people ages 12-17 with the knowledge, skills, and confidence** they need to navigate the challenges of adolescence and become leaders in their communities. Our curriculum covers a wide range of subjects, including Islamic studies, life skills, and community engagement.

Taleem ul-Quran and Tahfeedh ul-Quran: Connecting with the Quran

Taleem ul-Quran and Tahfeedh ul-Quran, provide students of all ages with the opportunity to deepen their understanding and connection with the Quran. We offer a variety of classes, from beginner to advanced levels, focusing on proper recitation, memorization, and comprehension.

Radiant Hearts Academy (RHA) is our preschool program, providing a **nurturing and stimulating environment for children ages 3-5**. We focus on early childhood development, offering a balanced curriculum that includes Islamic studies, academics, and creative activities.

- Distributed gift bags to patients at Northern Virginia Mental Health Institute
- Organized support groups for caregivers and individuals coping with grief
- Offered training in Mental Health First Aid and Narcan administration
- Conducted seminars on parenting, addiction, conflict resolution, and mental health

EMPOWERING THE NEXT GENERATION

Alhamdulillah, 2023 was another blessed year for the ADAMS Youth Department. ADAMS Youth and Young Adults (AYYA) and Qahwa witnessed remarkable achievements thanks to the dedicated staff and volunteers pushing our mission along. We have been able to establish a strategic and intentional structure around the youth program and have achieved incredible milestones as we continued to serve and empower our community.

Our events and programs have resonated deeply with the community. We have reestablished the youth qiyams which brought hundreds of young brothers and sisters in worship and reflection. We developed weekly and monthly halaqas catered towards diverse demographics, including middle school, high school, college, and young professionals; fostering learning and spiritual growth.

The ADAMS Youth sports programs played a pivotal role in promoting fitness and camaraderie among both brothers and sisters. Volleyball and basketball programs brought the community together on and off the court.





In the pursuit of holistic development, we introduced enrichment programs such as stargazing sessions, UMMATea, and mental health talks. Our intensives for young adults covered essential topics like marriage, personal finance, and mental health; equipping our youth with practical life skills. Service events were a cornerstone of our mission, with initiatives like Thanksgiving meal-packing, strengthening our bonds and giving back to the broader community.

ADAMS Youth remains deeply committed to our mission of serving and uplifting the ADAMS youth as well as the rest of the community. By the mercy of Allah, our programs have flourished, attracting a diverse array of participants and nurturing a sense of belonging.

2023 Year in Review

The ADAMS Children's Committee had a vibrant and impactful 2023, filled with engaging events and programs that fostered a sense of community, learning, and fun for our young members.



Monthly Highlights:

- ▶ January: Kicked off the year with the heartwarming "Ummi and Me" sessions in Sterling.
- February: Celebrated World Hijab Day with enriching events like Storytime & Crafts, a Tween Hijab Chat, and a thought-provoking Panel Discussion.
- ▶ March: Embraced the spirit of Ramadan with a "Ramadan Around The World" Celebration, a 30-Day Ramadan Challenge, and weekly Ramadan Story & Crafts sessions. Expanded "Ummi and Me" to Ashburn.
- ▶ April: Marked Eid with joyous celebrations at Monkey Joe's and an Ummi & Me Eid Party.
- ▶ May: Brought the "Ummi and Me" program to Leesburg.
- ▶ June: Hosted the Salam Summer Social and a meaningful Juneteenth celebration, educating children about its history and featuring a live reading and book signing with author Halimah Bashir.
- October: Enjoyed a delightful Day at Cox Farms and celebrated the Mercy to Mankind Mawlid.
- November: Over 50 children attended a heartwarming read-aloud of "The Gift of Shaykh Ahmadu Bamba" and met author Rukayat Yakub. The Tatreez for Palestine event raised over \$5,000 for Gaza relief while engaging over 200 children in Tatreez and Storytime.
- ▶ December: Nurtured creativity and well-being through Therapeutic Art and Science & Growth Mindset's Kids Therapeutic Art class. Ended the year with a festive Niyyah for the New Year Party featuring a reptile show and an inspiring reminder from Imam Daoud Nassimi.

Ongoing Programs:

► Weekly Programs:

- "Ummi and Me" continued to thrive in Leesburg, Sterling, and Ashburn, welcoming 40-50 children each week.
- Little Sisters Circle provided a safe and supportive space for young girls.
- Open Gym offered a fun and active outlet for children ages 2-12 on Friday nights.

Looking Ahead:

Building on the successes of 2023, the ADAMS Children's Committee is excited to continue creating enriching experiences for our young community members in the years to come. We remain dedicated to fostering a love of learning, faith, and community through engaging programs and events.



SOCIAL/WELLNESS/ZAKAH SERVICES:

COMPASSIONATE CARE

ADAMS Social, Wellness & Zakah Services: Extending a Helping Hand

In 2023, ADAMS Center's Social, Wellness, and Zakah Services department continued its mission to provide compassionate care and essential support to our community members. We recognize that financial hardship, mental health challenges, and unexpected life events can affect anyone, and we strive to offer a safety net for those in need.



SOCIAL/WELLNESS/ZAKAH SERVICES:

COMPASSIONATE CARE

Zakah Distribution:

We distributed **over \$203,909** in **Zakah funds to 255 cases**, ensuring that individuals and families had access to vital resources such as rent, utilities, food, and medical care. Our Elderly/Disabled and Family at Risk programs provided ongoing support to 21 families facing long-term challenges.

Community Support:

"In 2023 we spent \$522,765 on community welfare programs for families in need and utilized \$46,000 in religious and social activities for these families in our community. We also partnered with local and international nonprofit organizations, allocating \$1,215,673 to a range of domestic and international efforts all thanks to your support.

► Mental Health and Wellness:

Recognizing the importance of mental well-being, we collaborated with **11 mental health professionals to offer counseling and support services** to our community members. We also partnered with local organizations to provide Mental Health First Aid and Narcan administration training.

► Food Assistance and Community Outreach:

We partnered with **the Capital Area Food Bank to provide weekly food assistance** to families struggling to meet their basic needs. During Ramadan, we distributed essential food items to over 50 families, ensuring that everyone had access to nourishment during this holy month.

Education and Empowerment:

We allocated \$101,566.69 from the Zakah fund to support educational initiatives, fostering the next generation of Islamic leaders. During Eid Ul-Adha, we distributed Udhiyah meat and gift cards to eligible families, ensuring that everyone could celebrate this joyous occasion.

Collaborations and Training:

Our Social Services team partnered with various government and non-profit organizations, including FAITH, Loudoun County, Fairfax County, SCAN, Women Giving Back, and the Capital Area Food Bank. We conducted training sessions on mental health crisis de-escalation, mandatory reporting of child abuse, parenting skills, addiction recovery, and conflict resolution.

Looking Ahead:

In 2024 and beyond, ADAMS Center's **Social/Wellness/Zakah Services department will continue to expand its reach**, offering a wider range of programs and resources to support our community's well-being. We are committed to fostering a compassionate and inclusive environment where everyone feels valued and empowered to thrive.



2023: A Year of Operational Excellence

In 2023, the ADAMS Center Operations team focused on enhancing our facilities, improving efficiency, and ensuring the safety and comfort of our community members. We've made significant strides in optimizing our resources and streamlining processes, allowing us to better serve the needs of our growing community.

Key Accomplishments:

Facility Enhancements:

- ▶ Conducted bi-annual renovations and upgrades to all ADAMS School areas.
- ▶ Maintained and improved the main building's infrastructure, including elevators and fire alarms.
- ▶ Installed chair rails, baseboards, and moldings on Main level.
- ▶ Upgraded the sound system and streaming camera in the Main Musalla.

Cost Savings and Efficiency:

- ▶ Purchased over 300 chairs and 50 foldable tables at a significant discount.
- ▶ Implemented measures to ensure the safety of the Masjid and community members, eliminating the need for some costly security guards.
- ► Contracted with a new cleaning company, providing improved service, especially during Ramadan.
- ▶ Maintained the parking lot drainage system, ensuring compliance and avoiding hefty fines.

Community Services and Support:

- Provided a limo bus for overflow parking during Ramadan and Eid.
- ▶ Continued to offer a range of community services to members.
- Organized and controlled traffic during Friday prayers and special events.
- ▶ Upgraded security measures throughout the building, providing peace of mind for staff and visitors. Handled invoices and maintenance for all ADAMS branches.
- ▶ Provided security for all ADAMS branches during various events.

The Operations team's dedication and hard work have made a tangible difference in the daily lives of our community members. We are proud of our accomplishments in 2023 and look forward to continuing to enhance the ADAMS Center experience for everyone.
