Opportunity

ADAMS Center wishes to partner with domestic nonprofit organizations to ensure that families have the food and/or other essentials they need to celebrate Eid Al Fitr 2024.

Proposals can include programming such as the following, but are not limited to:

- Eid Mela / Events
- Food box distributions
- Hot meal distributions
- Toy and clothes distributions
- Direct cash distributions
- Gift card distributions

Activities must be within the last week of Ramadan and the three days of Eid to ensure proper use of Zakat al Fitr funds.

ADAMS Center anticipates entering into multiple partnership agreements.

Please note that funds will be released based on 90-10; 90% payment will be made on agreement signing, with the final 10% to be released upon receipt of the final report.

Eligibility

The eligible applicant for this opportunity announcement is limited to registered IRS 501(c)3 nonprofit organizations. Priority will be given to DMV (DC, Maryland, VA) based organizations before considering out-of-state.

Funding will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis until the depletion of funds.
