ABOUT RAMADAN AT ADAMS

IMPORTANT DATES

- Khatm al Qur'an (29th Night) April 7
- Eid ul Fitr April 10

MASJID HOURS & I'TIKAF

- Masjid Hours: Open until midnight (first 20 nights), Duha prayer (last 10 nights).
- I'tikaf: First-come, first-served (last 10 nights).

PARKING & TRANSPORTATION

- Overflow Parking: Will be available at Rolling Ridge Elementary School.
- Shuttle Bus: Will run from ADAMS to Rolling Ridge Elementary School every 10 min. from 9 PM to 12 AM.
- HOV Parking: Vehicles with three or more occupants must park near the main entrance.
- Non-HOV Parking: Vehicles with two or fewer occupants must park further away from the main entrance in the larger parking lot.
- Illegal Parking: Vehicles parked illegally (fire lanes, double-parked, or illegal handicap) will be towed.

WHERE DO WE EAT IFTAR AND SUHOOR?

- Locations: If it's below 60°F we'll eat iftar & suhoor at the gym. If it's above 60°F we'll eat at the pavilion.
- Suhoor: Provided last 10 nights.

ANY SPECIAL NOTES FOR BROTHERS, SISTERS OR CHILDREN?

- Brothers: No access to the upper level from Maghrib until closing.
- Sisters: No access to the lower level from Maghrib until closing.
- Musalla: Children under 6 are not allowed in musalla the during prayer times. Children not old enough to drive must have adult supervision in the main musalla.
- Gym: Open for all children during Taraweeh.
- Babysitters: Services are available on the lower level during Isha and Taraweeh prayers.
- Special Needs Respite Care: for ages 5+ on Wed. & Sat. in Ramadan, from Isha to 8 rakat of Taraweeh. Register at tinyurl.com/respitecarerequestADAMS
